Qualifications

- Must be a naturalized or U.S. born citizen and be commissioned by the age 42 (age waiver may apply).
- Must be a graduate of a school of nursing accredited by the National league for Nursing Accreditation Commission (NLNAC) or the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) that conferred a nursing baccalaureate or an advanced nursing degree.
- Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above (waiver may apply).
- Must possess a current license, in good standing, to practice as a registered professional nurse from a State or territory of the U.S. or the District of Columbia, awarded upon successful completion of the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX).
- General qualifications will depend upon whether currently serving, whether served before or with no service. Active duty, FTS and Reserve personnel may apply.
